Unsafe water kills more people than any form of violence including war, according to the UN. Georgia Assemblies of God KidMin Department, a non-profit organization, has partnered with The Africa Oasis Project to build safe water wells in an area that has one of the worst water problems in the entire world. The Oasis Project is an aggressive effort to respond to the critical problem of inadequate and unsafe water creating high-risk in the lives of people throughout Africa.

The Oasis Road Race will be held on the grounds of Timber Lake Retreat Center in Forsyth, GA on Saturday, October 23, 2021. Due to our extensive advertising promotion, we expect to have many participants from Macon, Warner Robins, and around middle Georgia. Below are the different levels of contribution and the benefits of each to your business or church. **Sponsors need to have all information into our office by October 1, 2021.**

- 1. Bronze: Sponsorship of \$50-\$99 Business/Church name listed on race day T-shirt
- 2. Silver: Donations of \$100 \$499 Business/Church name printed on of the race day banners, business name listed on t-shirt, and 1 free race registration

O A S I S ROAD RACE

The **11th Annual Georgia Children's Ministries 5K Road Race and 1 Mile Fun Run** is planned for Saturday, October 23, 2021 at Camp Timberlake located at 1721 GA-83 in Forsyth, GA. The 1 Mile Fun Run will begin at 8:00 am and the 5K Run will begin at 8:30 am.

We are so excited about this year's Oasis Race, and we are believing God to help us raise \$40,000 to drill two wells. Will you please consider helping us meet this critical need for clean water? Every time you drink a sip of water, remember the children and adults who suffer because of the lack of clean water.

I'm challenging all Lead Pastors, Children's Pastors/Leaders, church staff, and congregation members to join me running/walking in this year's race. **All runners will receive a Race Day T-shirt.** Medals and pins will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each age group for both categories - male and female. Get your kids involved as well. Let them know that by their running/walking, they are helping a kid in Africa have clean water. Together, we can really make a difference! **For every 15 people your church brings in person to the Oasis Race, you will receive one FREE Kids Camp Scholarship!**

HOW TO RAISE BGMC MONEY WITH THE OASIS ROAD RACE?

- **Consider being a sponsoring church.** Depending on the size of your sponsorship, your church will be recognized verbally as well as on our race day t-shirts and banners.
- Plan to Run/Walk in the race and ask others in your church to register. For every race registration (\$25), your church will receive \$10 BGMC giving credit! You can even have phantom runners (people who register but will not run/walk in the race). All registrations, including phantom runners, will receive a race day t-shirt! IMPORTANT you must send us an email with the names of the people who are registering from your church to get credit for them.
- Take up pledges for you running/walking in the race. Several churches have done this, and one church raised \$10,000 when the pastor made the challenge! This is a great way for the kids to get involved and help raise money for the Oasis Road Race.
- Ask businesses to become a Sponsor of the Race. Even though you are not in the location of the race, businesses will still donate toward this very worthy cause. We've had many businesses outside of Macon give donations. Some will even sponsor you in this race.

We have hired **Orion Racing** again this year for the timing, which will provide the latest chip technology plus real time results on a flat screen TV at the finish line. Looking forward to seeing you at the Oasis Road Race!

Assemblies of God World Missions – Africa has launched a major effort to respond to Africa's critical need for safe and available water.

Water

70% of the earth's surface is covered by water.
97% of the earth's water is in the oceans.
Only 3% of the total global water is fresh. It is not evenly distributed around the world.
Much of the fresh water is in aquifers, deep below the earth's surface – more than 800 meters.

The Need

Africa has about 9% of the world's water resources but 13% of the world's population. This means that the amount of water for each person is well below the world average and often at great distance from the people. Africa's women and children are often obligated to use large segments of their time and energy daily in hauling water.

Predictions indicate that over the next 20 years, 30% more water will be needed just for farming. Twenty-five African nations will suffer water shortages. When there is too little water, drought occurs. Drought is the third most common disaster in Africa. Drought contributes to degrading the environment (deforestation, loss of land cover, soil erosion, overgrazing, etc.) food shortages due to crop failure, death of animals...leading to hunger and malnutrition, declining health and sanitation...an increase in sickness and disease as a result. Africa has the lowest coverage of water supply and sanitation services in the world.

The Solution

Africa Oasis Project, partnering with our national churches through Africa, is focused on providing appropriate solutions on a foundation of recognized best practice methods. The range of responses to local situations will include, among other actions...

- Deep-water wells
- Sanitation training for maintaining water in sanitary conditions once gathered.
- Rainwater harvesting and storage
- Irrigation
- Sewage management
